the evolution of computing programming language fundamentals by example provides an understanding of the many languages and notations used in computer science the formal models used to design phases and the foundations of languages including linguistics this textbook guides students through the process of implementing a simple interpreter with case based exercises questions and a semester long project that encompasses all of the concepts and theories presented in the book into one concrete example it covers also such topics as formal grammars automata denotational and axiomatic semantics and rule based presentation

this engaging and important study examines the evolution of tv news and its long history of blending journalism and entertainment american historical review today s media critics often decry the state of television news saying that it s too dumbed down becoming more entertainment than information but this familiar narrative fails to acknowledge real changes in media and americans news consuming habits it also harkens back to a golden age that on closer examination is revealed to be not so golden as charles l ponce de leon explains in that s the way it is tv news has always walked a fine line between hard news and fluff ponce de leon traces the entire history of televised news from the household names of the late 1940s and early 50s like eric sevaroid edward r murrow and walter cronkite through the rise of cable the political power of fox news and the satirical punch of colbert and stewart he describes an industry forever in transition where newsmagazines and celebrity profiles vie with political news and serious investigations the need for ratings success and the lighter human interest stories that can help bring it ponce de leon makes clear has always sat uneasily alongside a real desire to report hard news highlighting the paradoxes at the heart of tv news and telling a story rich in familiar figures and fascinating anecdotes that s the way it is offers an insightful and engaging account of how television has presented our history as it happens

in this book leading historian of education jeffrey e mirel retells a story we think we know in which public schools forced a draconian americanization on the great waves of immigration of a century ago ranging from the 1890s through the world war ii years mirel argues that americanization was a far more nuanced and negotiated process from the start much shaped by immigrants themselves drawing from detailed descriptions of americanization programs for both schoolchildren and adults in three cities chicago cleveland and detroit and from extensive analysis of foreign language newspapers mirel shows how immigrants confronted different kinds of americanization when native born citizens contemptuously tried to force them to forsake their home religions languages or histories immigrants pushed back strongly

while they passionately embraced key aspects of americanization the english language american history democratic political ideas and citizenship they also found in american democracy a defense of their cultural differences in seeing no conflict between their sense of themselves as italians or germans or poles and americans they helped to create a new and inclusive vision of this country mirel vividly retells the epic story of one of the great achievements of american education which has profound implications for the americanization of immigrants today

this text explores the aesthetics underlying logics and histories of two seemingly distinct genres liberal political satire and conservative opinion talk making the case that they should be thought of as the logical extensions of the psychology of the left and right respectively

contradictory to its core the sitcom an ostensibly conservative tranquilizing genre has a long track record in the united states of tackling controversial subjects with a fearlessness not often found in other types of programming but the sitcom also conceals as much as it reveals masking the rationale for socially deviant or deleterious behavior behind figures of ridicule whose motives are rarely disclosed fully over the course of a thirty minute episode examining a broad range of network and cable tv shows across the history of the medium from classic working class comedies such as the honeymooners all in the family and roseanne to several contemporary cult series animated programs and online hits that have yet to attract much scholarly attention this book explores the ways in which social imaginaries related to bad behavior have been humorously exploited over the years the repeated appearance of socially wayward figures on the small screen from raging alcoholics to brainwashed cult members to actual monsters who are merely exaggerated versions of our own inner demons has the dual effect of reducing complex individuals to recognizable types while neutralizing the presumed threats that they pose such representations not only provide strangely comforting reminders that badness is a cultural construct but also prompt audiences to reflect on their own unspoken proclivities for antisocial behavior if only in passing

this informative two volume set provides readers with an understanding of the fads and crazes that have taken america by storm from colonial times to the present entries cover a range of topics including food entertainment fashion music and language why could hula hoops and tv westerns only have been found in every household in the 1950s what murdered russian princess can be seen in one of the first documented selfies taken in 1914 this book answers those questions and more in its documentation of all of the most captivating trends that have defined american popular culture since before the country began entries are well researched and alphabetized by decade at the start of every section is an insightful historical overview of the decade and the set uniquely illustrates what today s readers have in common with the past it also contains a glossary of slang for each

decade as well as a bibliography plus suggestions for further reading for each entry students and readers interested in history will enjoy discovering trends through the years in such areas as fashion movies music and sports

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
