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jill mccorkle tells the varied tales of today's southern women the lives they end up leading and the loves that distract them stuck in the slow lane gunning their motors they are women living the real life hoping things will get better but surprised when they occasionally do

this unique literary anthology presents the childhood writings of some of america's greatest authors including stephen king joyce carol oates and more most kid write stories a few of them grow up to be successful authors before stephen king created carrie he created jhonathan at age nine and before there was rabbit angstrom there was manuel citarro the detective in john updike's hard boiled mystery written at fourteen before jurassic park there was young michael crichton's story about the mysteriously wounded man lying unattended in the street editor paul mandelbaum persuaded our most popular american authors to share their childhood writings and their treasured photographs what he's gathered is a fascinating delightful collection of writing and early snapshots that reveal young minds at work wrestling with early versions of ideas that were to take hold of their writings in later years of course the young madeline l engle would wonder about space and the meaning of eternity of course margaret atwood would question conventional female behavior arguing for the right to smoke cigars other writers featured in this volume include amy tan paul bowles michael crichton ursula k

sena jeter naslund describes the origins of ahab s wife in a vision and a voice ann patchett mourns the ways in which the reality of a novel may fail to live up to her conception of it andrea barrett a winner of the national book award and the recipient of a macarthur fellowship nevertheless characterizes herself as a very clumsy writer in her early drafts the seventeen women interviewed by sarah anne johnson are some of the most popular and accomplished writers at work today award winners critically acclaimed popular with book clubs steeped in a thorough knowledge of each writer s work johnson s questions range from technical issues of craft to the nurturing of fictional ideas to the daily practice of writing the authors offer insights into their own works that will delight their fans and also provide practical advice that will be cherished by aspiring writers from chitra banerjee divakaruni s reflections on her experience of immigration to lois ann yamanaka s insights on the question of a character s voice these interviews combine the personal with the professional experience of the writing life

the language of power women and literature 1945 to the present examines the upheaval in social relations within the last half of the twentieth century and argues that issues of power have had a profound effect on women s lives and literature interdisciplinary in scope the book analyzes women s attitudes toward work marriage sex and the family traditional religion and spirituality race class and ethnicity and artistic creativity the language of power surveys many of the most important american british and world female authors writing in contemporary culture

this anthology celebrates the tenth anniversary of the novello festival of reading one of the premier literary events in the country all of the writers in the book have appeared at novello which is sponsored by the public library of charlotte and mecklenburg county named national library of the year in 1995 this diverse collection of prose represents not only the best of novello but also a sampler of some of the best writing of our time whether as journalists columnists war correspondents or writers of fiction memoir and humor the twenty five contributors have won nearly every award a writer could covet some of the essays and stories in this anthology may be familiar to readers but many appear here in print for the first time charles kuralt reminisces about a time when old ways began to give way to modern life pat conroy crafts a raw and wryly funny remembrance of his now deceased father donald conroy the inspiration for the great santini in his selection david halberstam offers a look back at his early career when he covered the civil rights upheavals in mississippi novelists lee smith and nanci kincaid introduce readers to their new works in progress and sandra goven a scholar and professor of african american literature tells a true life story about her childhood bibliomania and where it led

when jill mccorkle feels a short story coming on she goes right ahead and wastes wonderful ideas instead of hoarding them for a novel the result is another extraordinary collection of stories and characters in it s a funeral rsvp the storyteller is a woman who takes up self styled careers that suit her circumstances now she s stumbled onto one that s so successful that she just can t quit it s planning funerals what she calls going out parties in which the clients are the soon to be deceased themselves in life prerecorded perhaps mccorkle s finest short piece to date the pregnant narrator finds the real meaning of new life by visiting with a very old neighbor who s waiting too for his own new life in these and the rest of the nine stories jill mccorkle acts on her penchant for taming the outrageous humanizing the forbidden and grounding the hilarious

offering a comprehensive view of the south s literary landscape past and present this volume of the new encyclopedia of southern culture celebrates the region s ever flourishing literary culture and recognizes the ongoing evolution of the southern literary canon as new writers draw upon and reshape previous traditions southern literature has broadened and deepened its connections not just to the american literary mainstream but also to world literatures a development thoughtfully explored in the essays here greatly expanding the content of the literature section in the original encyclopedia this volume includes 31 thematic essays addressing major genres of literature theoretical categories such as regionalism the southern gothic and agrarianism and themes in southern writing such as food religion and sexuality most striking is the fivefold increase in the number of biographical entries which introduce southern novelists playwrights poets and critics special attention is given to contemporary writers and other individuals who have not been widely covered in previous scholarship

this new edition of southern writers assumes its distinguished predecessor s place as the essential reference on literary artists of the american south broadly expanded and thoroughly revised it boasts 604 entries nearly double the earlier edition s written by 264 scholars for every figure major and minor from the venerable and canonical to the fresh and innovative a biographical sketch and chronological list of published works provide comprehensive concise up to date information here in one convenient source are the south s novelists and short story writers poets and dramatists memoirists and essayists journalists scholars and biographers from the colonial period to the twenty first century what constitutes a southern writer is always a matter for debate editors joseph m flora and amber vogel have used a generous definition that turns on having a significant connection to the region in either a personal or literary sense new to this volume are younger writers who have emerged in the quarter century since the dictionary s original publication as well as older talents previously unknown or unacknowledged for almost every writer found in the previous edition a new biography has been commissioned drawn from the very best minds on southern literature and covering the full spectrum of its practitioners southern writers is an indispensable reference book for anyone intrigued by the subject
